

WHO'S LOBBYING WHO IN BC?

Monthly Snapshot – October 2024

The following is a brief summary of new Registration Returns activated or re-activated between October 1 and October 31, 2024, under BC's *Lobbyists Transparency Act*.

1. Jill Briggs, a consultant lobbyist, is lobbying public office holders at several public agencies on behalf of Facebook Canada Ltd., regarding matters impacting online digital platforms, including but not limited to broader policy issues such as population-level harms in Bill 12 (42-5) *Public Health Accountability and Cost Recovery Act*.
2. Dennis Chan, a consultant lobbyist with Pathway Strategies Inc, is lobbying public office holders at several public agencies on behalf of Takeda Canada Inc. regarding the public funding/coverage of drug therapies marketed by the client.
3. Stephen Filbey, a consultant lobbyist with WestPAR Consultancy Inc., is lobbying public office holders at the Ministry of Health on behalf of AVIR Pharma Inc. regarding funding and coverage through PLBSD for products including Cresemba and Mezera.
4. Stephanie Korolyk, a consultant lobbyist, is lobbying public office holders at several public agencies on behalf of Coalition for Healthy School Food regarding policy and program recommendations regarding the development and implementation of a school food program for all K-12 students in BC and across Canada as well as funding from provincial and federal governments for a universal, cost-shared, health-promoting school food program.

5. Animal Justice Canada Legislative Fund is lobbying public office holders at several public agencies regarding measures to end the suffering of animals used in rodeos, including an end to provincial subsidies for rodeo events in British Columbia.
6. BHE Canada Limited is lobbying public office holders at several public agencies regarding cross-border transaction of interties and renewable energy on behalf of BHE Canada, L.P.
7. Canadian Men's Health Foundation is lobbying public office holders at several public agencies seeking provincial support to help men across British Columbia adopt life-style changes for healthier outcomes.
8. First United Church Community Ministry Society is lobbying public office holders at several public agencies regarding changes to the Residential Tenancy Act to strengthen renters' rights and alleviate bad faith evictions and funding for the non-residential portion of the redevelopment project from the Ministry of Housing.
9. FPX Nickel Corp. is lobbying public office holders at several public agencies regarding the continuation and enhancement of British Columbia's Critical Mineral's Strategy and funding to advance FPX Nickel Corp.'s Baptiste Nickel Project.
